- 25X1 ¹. The west shore of the port of Makarska, destroyed during the war, is presently under repair. In the port is a small pier approximately fafty to sawy revers in length. At the entry to the port two tunnels, begun by the Germans and completed under Tito, have been constructed. The tunnels are approximately twenty meters in length and serve as shelters for torpedo boats.
 - 2. A People's Militia station and a small KNOJ unit comprise the only military protection for the port.
