1. The Presov (R 49/E 37) military and civilian airfield was about 900 x 1,400 meters. The firm and loamy soil was covered with grass. The landing field was level. \*
2. One hangar, wooden houses serving as quarters, depots and other buildings were seen at the field. \*\*
3. The field was occupied by military aircraft, one twin-engine Dakota which was used for parachuting, and about 6 light planes of the local Aero club. The military unit stationed there was equipped with about 8 to 10 planes of different types. \*\*\*

25X1 [redacted] Comment. [redacted] The buildings are reported for the first time. There are five temporary buildings along the road. [redacted]

25X1 [redacted] Comment. The information that the field was occupied by a small and undetermined military unit and used by the local Aero club agrees with reports of 1948/1949. A previous report indicated that a parachute unit was transferred to the field. [redacted]
