1. This mine, located in the village of Sase, District of Srebrenica, Bosnia, allegedly is very rich in zinc, lead and silver ore. It was destroyed at the end of the last war, and although it was reopened in the spring of 1949, the work still has not progressed beyond the exploratory stages. An ore processing plant is to be constructed on the nearby Drina River.
  2. The mine is equipped with six Ingersoll Rand compressors, and Ingersoll Rand digging machines, and an electric plant will soon be installed to provide electric power for the mine.
  3. Administrative Director of the mine is Bude Pejnovic, and Technical Director is Milan Lukic. There are 150 poorly trained miners and an administrative staff of fifteen.
