An one processing plant is to be constructed on the hearby Drina River.
- The mine is equipped with six Ingersoll Rand compressors, and Ingersoll Rand digging machines, and an electric plant will soon be installed to provide electric power for the mine.
- 3. Administrative Director of the mine is Bude Pejnoviv, and Technical Director is Milan Lukic. There are 150 poorly trained miners and an administrative staff of fifteen.
