During the period [Redacted] December, daily Soviet leave traffic through Frankfurt/Oder averaged 400 soldiers going to Brest-Litovsk and 810 soldiers coming from Brest-Litovsk. About 100 officers of all branches of service passed through Frankfurt/Oder and proceeded westward. (6)

6. The following military movements were observed in the Frankfurt/Oder area [Redacted] December:

a. About 75 officers arrived on three trucks from the Hofbauer Kaserne, Frankfurt/Oder and boarded the leave train bound for Schwerin [Redacted]

b. One flatcar with two 30-mm AA guns having outrigger-type mounts stood at the Strausberg railroad station [Redacted]

c. The leave train from Brest-Litovsk which arrived at the Frankfurt/Oder railroad station [Redacted] was occupied to capacity. About 100 new officers went to the Hofbauer Kaserne on four trucks.

d. The leave train from Brest Litovsk which arrived at the Frankfurt/Oder railroad station [Redacted] was heavily occupied. About 60 percent of the occupants were officers.

e. Fifty old, [Redacted] trucks arrived in Frankfurt/Oder [Redacted] coming from Brest-Litovsk.

f. Officers from the Hofbauer Kaserne, Frankfurt/Oder, arrived at the railroad station on four trucks [Redacted] and boarded the leave train bound for Magdeburg. (6)

7. No military rail shipments were seen passing through Pasewalk [Redacted]

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8. No indications of any unusual railroad operations were observed in Kuestrin and Frankfurt/Oder up to [redacted]
