1. The airfield at Pruszez (P54/Dll) is situated north of the town and east of the Gdansk-Tczew railroad line. This field was constructed by the Germans during World War II, and destroyed when they retreated from the region in 1944-1945. Since the war, the Gdansk Aeroclub has unsuccessfully attempted to interest authorities in repairing the field. In October, 1950, it was still in a state of complete disrepair, with destroyed hangars, large bomb holes in the runways, and grown over with grass.
