THIS IS UNEVALUATED INFORMATION

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1. The airfield at Bruszez (P54/D11) is situated north of the town and east of the Gdansk-Tczew railroad line. This field was constructed by the Germans during World War II, and destroyed when they retreated from the region in 1944-1945. Since the war, the Gdansk Aeroclub has unsuccessfully attempted to interest authorities in repairing the field. In October, 1950, it was still in a state of complete disrepair, with destroyed hangars, large bomb holes in the runways, and grown over with grass.

* [redacted] Comment: This report is in complete disagreement with [redacted] which states that in March 1950 the airfield was rapidly being reclaimed under orders of the Ministry of National Defense.
