1. On 10 February 1951 the following units of the 24th Air Army were observed flying:

One fighter regiment each at Alt-Lönnowitz, Parchim, Lärz, Zerbst, Brandenburg, Grossenhain, and Brandis.

One bomber regiment at Jüterbog, which had previously been observed at Werneuchen or Strausberg.

Two ground-attack regiments at Döberitz.

2. On 12 February there was little flying activity, probably because of bad weather. The only unit observed was a fighter regiment at Neubrandenburg.
