

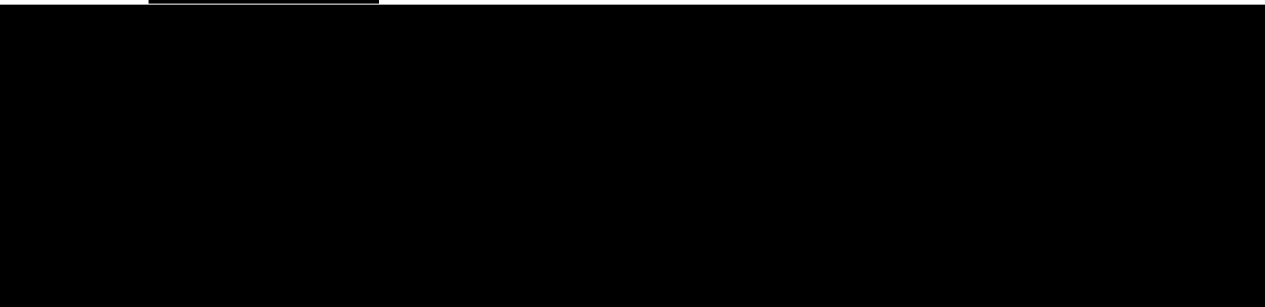

- 25X1A 1. The 3rd Independent Armored Scouting Battalion, formerly stationed in Szombathely, was transferred on [redacted] to Sarvár, 20 kilometers to the east. Only about 35 men remained in the cavalry barracks in Szombathely.
- 25X1B 2. The commander of the battalion is Lt. Col. Gyula Sarodi; the deputy commander is Maj. István Károly. [redacted] The battalion has the following subordinate units:
 - 1 company of tanks. Strength, 85 men, equipped with 8 T-34 tanks.
 - 1 company of assault artillery; 65 men, with 6 "Nimrod cars".
 - 1 company of anti-tank artillery; about 100 men, with six 76.2 mm. guns and three 40 mm. automatic guns (Russian).
 - 2 companies of motorized infantry; about 150 men each.
 - 1 reconnaissance platoon; 35 men.
 - 1 motorcycle platoon; 40 men.
 - 1 mortar platoon; 50 men, with four 82 mm. mortars and six 52 mm. mortars.
 - 1 platoon of engineers; about 40 men.

Equipment includes 21 Botond (sic) trucks, 8 General Motors prime movers, and 16 motorcycles, 10 with side-cars.
- 25X1X 3. [redacted] alleges that the battalion is attached to a 9th Motorized Infantry Division, with headquarters at Celldömölk. [redacted]
