1. Colonel Andrei Aleksandrovich Listvin was billeted at 6 Quellweg, Berlin-Pankow, in a restricted billeting area for Soviet officers. He was director of the DPA, a Soviet licensed newsreel studio, which has its office on Jaegerstrasse in Berlin-Mitte.

25X1A 2. Three letters obtained at Colonel Listvin's residence on 20 December 1950 showed [REDACTED]. They were dated 30 September, 6 and 13 October 1950, examined by Censorship Offices [REDACTED] and all were mailed from Moscow.
