THIS IS UNEVALUATED INFORMATION

1. The airfield is approximately 3 km northeast of Penza (53°12'N/45°01'E), Penza Oblast, approximately 350 meters north of the road to Sliksa (53°12'N/45°18'E). The field, which was surrounded by level terrain, seemed to be very large. A building with a wind sock was in the north-western corner of the field.
2. Approximately 30 biplanes and twin-engine aircraft were standing on two parking sites.
3. Three twin-engine aircraft towing one cargo glider each were occasionally seen flying over the town. The gliders were larger than the twin-engine planes. It was not observed that the gliders were released. The aircraft were apparently stationed at the airfield northeast of the town since they always came from and returned in that direction.
