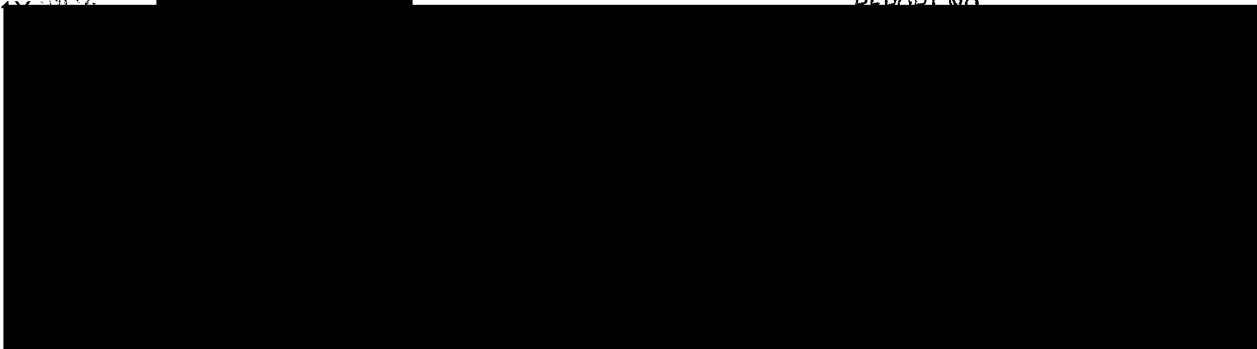

1. A United Central Council of Refugees (UCCR) has been formed in Calcutta. On it are representatives of the Forward Bloc, the Revolutionary Communist Party of India, the Revolutionary Socialist Party of India, the Socialist Republican Party and the Communist Party of India.
2. The purpose of the UCCR is to cause anti-Government agitation among the refugees, not only in Calcutta but in Hooghly, Cooch Bihar, Nadia and 24-Parganas. In late January clashes between police and refugees took place in Dinajpur and Malda Districts.
3. Professor Meghnad Saha presides over the UCCR. It is financed in part by Hembrishna Dalmaia, whose journal, Satyajug, is the mouthpiece of refugee malcontents.
4. Dr. Shyama Prasad Mookherjee has no official connection with the UCCR.
