6. During the period from 6 to 11 January, daily Soviet leave traffic through Frankfurt/Oder averaged 400 soldiers going to Brest Litovsk and 630 soldiers coming from Brest Litovsk. Officers of all branches of service arrived in Frankfurt/Oder at a rate of about 80 per day

confirms the main medical depot of the GDFG in Fuerstenwalde until 9 January

has been repeatedly reported from Frankfurt/Oder since October 1950 in connection with incoming and outgoing shipments of military goods and fuel.
