4. A train of 40 boxcars occupied by soldiers left Cottbus toward Berlin on 13 February 1951. Many Soviet military patrols were observed at the railroad stations of Cottbus, Luebbenau, Koenigswusterhausen, and Berlin-Ostbahnhof.

* [redacted] Comment. These shipments were part of the movement of air force units from Werneuchen to Justerbog and from Justerbog to Brandenburg.

** [redacted] Comment. The tanks possibly belonged to a unit of the 7th Gds Mecc Div in Frankfurt/Oder.
