probably belongs to a transport control office at the Schoenefeld airfield near Berlin.

on several vouchers made out by the Taegliche Rundschau since November 1950.

A is assigned to the Eighth Gds Army newspaper Na Zashchitu Rodiny.

belongs to the Hq GDFG.

A belongs to the GDFG newspaper Sovietskaya Armiya.

was observed with an unidentified supply office in Land Saxony in March 1948 and has been reported in connection with the Taegliche Rundschau since October 1950.
