1. Large troop shipments from Chungking to Hankow will take place as soon as the water level of the Yangtze permits. The CHIANG MING (江明) will be one of the ships used for these movements.
2. On 19 March, 814 Chinese Communist troops of the Hupeh Military District, including 97 logistical personnel, left Shashih (112-17, 30-16) for Hankow aboard the MIN KUO (民貴).
3. On 20 March, 250 Chinese Communist troops left Wanh sien (108-24, 30-49) for Ich'ang (111-17, 30-42) aboard the CHANG LO (長樂).
4. On 20 March, 300 troops left Wanh sien for Ich'ang on the MIN WU (民武).
5. On 21 March, 500 troops left Wanh sien for Ich'ang aboard the HUA CHUNG (華中); 181 troops left on the HAO F'NG (鶴峯).
