- 1. On 7 March 1951, four light AA guns were observed to be emplaced 300 meters north of the Strassburg Kaserne and about 1 km northwest of Oberer Bahnhof, Grimma (N 52/E 40), on the Grimma-Leipzig railroad line. Officers and EM were observed to assemble in front of a large earth shelter 60 meters west of the AA guns. The guns had a caliber of about 25 mm and were mounted on low carriages, measuring about 2x3 meters. *

* [REDACTED] Comment. The AA gun emplacements are reported for the first time. They were probably maintained for training purposes by elements of the 8th Gds Mecz Div in Grimma.
