1. No troop trains were [Redacted] observed at, the 25X1
 Kuestrin-Kietz railroad station between 28 February and 5 March 1951.
 Trains which may have been military ones included an eastbound train
 of 10 boxcars with military goods, coming from the direction of
 Frankfurt/Oder on 28 February; a westbound train of 40 boxcars with
 grain, [Redacted] going to Berlin-Ostbahnhof on 25X1
 2 March; and an eastbound empty shuttle-train of 56 boxcars, coming
 from the direction of Frankfurt/Oder on 5 March.

 Frankfurt/Oder railroad station between 6 and 8 March 1951 included:

3. Daily Soviet leave traffic through Frankfurt/Oder averaged 365 soldiers going to Brest Litovsk and 445 soldiers coming from Brest Litovsk on 6 and 7 March. There was no change in the train schedule.

4. About 100 troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets, 8 AA guns of about 85 mm caliber, 14 trucks and one tank truck were loaded on a train at the Potsdam railroad station on 28 February.
