1. Between 23 February and 1 March 1951, Staaken (N 53/Z 65) airfield was still occupied by a single-engine ground attack unit. There was no flying, probably because of the deep snow on the runway. The weather was good. The rotating searchlight was in operation on the evenings of 26 and 28 February. \*

2. It was rumored that the western section of Staaken which was confiscated by the Soviets was to be occupied soon by Soviet troops.

\*                      Comment. The occupation of the airfield had apparently not changed. The field is occupied by one ground attack regiment equipped with Il-10s. The other two regiments also assigned to the same division are stationed at the airfields of Brandenburg-Arado and Koethen.                      an air transport squadron is also stationed at the Staaken airfield.
