50X1-HUM

1. A troop train of 62 cars, carrying officers and enlisted men passed through Woltersdorf (N53/V04) on 27 March 1951, going in the direction of Berlin. (1)
2. A military train of 30 cars, carrying troops and 22 AT guns of the Ninth Mechanized Division, was observed en route from Cottbus to Qandruf on 30 March. (2)
3. Elements of an unidentified AT artillery brigade (3) moved by road from Brandenburg to Altengrabow on 3 April.
4. The advance parties of Russian military personnel which arrived in Muensdorf at the end of March [redacted] departed in the direction of Baruth (N53/E99) on 3 April. They took 240 women with them. 50X1-HUM
5. An advance party of six aircraft arrived in Stendal on 2 April. (5) On 6 April 16 crates containing aircraft were observed en route from Brest-Litovsk to Koethen.
6. On 5 April Zerbst airfield was apparently evacuated by the flying units stationed there. The landing beacons were removed.

Comments:

50X1-HUM

- (1) This was possibly a component of the unidentified AAA division of the Fourth Guards Mechanized Army returning from Jueterbog.
- (2) [redacted] personnel being loaded on trains at Cottbus on 24 March. The troops observed were probably an advance element of the headquarters of the Ninth Mechanized Division. 50X1-HUM
- (3) Possibly the Third Guards AT Artillery Brigade.
- (4) [redacted]
- (5) The craft probably came from Koethen.
