1. A train carrying 16 pontoons and 10 soldiers wearing red-bordered black epaulots passed through Frankfurt/Oder on 14 March 1951. The train came from Bad Freienwalde and proceeded toward Bierswalde. *

- 3. On 17 March, 40 flatcars, [redacted] weighing eight tons and 12 boxcars with military goods were en route from Brest Litovsk to Zerbst, Finow and Falkenberg. [redacted]

- 4. Daily Soviet leave traffic through Frankfurt/Oder averaged 320 soldiers going to Brest Litovsk and 390 soldiers coming from Brest Litovsk during the period from 15 to 19 March. [redacted]
