1. On 14 April 1951 at 10 a. m., sixteen Soviet single-engine aircraft crashed in the Luckau (N 52/A 17) - Dabau (N 52/E 97) area.

2. On 14 April, 30 single-engine ground attack aircraft practiced flying at the Schoenwalde (N 53/Z 66) airfield: between 7:30 a. m. and 6:45 p. m. sixteen aircraft crashed on the same day. *

* Comment. According to press reports, the crashes were caused by stormy weather. The aircraft were probably IL-10s of the ground attack regiment stationed in Schoenwalde.
