1. Between 26 March and 7 April 1951, ground attack firing was practiced daily by six jet aircraft over Anklam (N 54/U 99) airfield. Eight ground targets, in the shape of four-engine planes, were visibly marked by white sand. Practices were held daily, except Saturday afternoons and Sundays, from 8 a. m. to noon and from 1:30 to 6 p. m. The aircraft approached from the north and departed in the same direction. \*
