- Up to July 1947, the administrative center of SAG Pribor (instruments), headed by general manager Tofanov (fnu) was located in Askaniahaus, Berlin-Weissensee. This SAG was transferred in July 1947 to 12 Karl-Heinestrasse in Leipzig (N 52/E 21) and one Dubovik (fnu) became general manager.
- SAG Pribor comprised the following enterprises:
  - Schaefer & Budenberg (Geratetechnik), Magdeburg (M 53/Y 60)
  - Geratetechnik, Schoenebeck/Elbe (M 53/D 78)
  - Steinle & Hartung Plant, Quedlinburg (M 52/D 35)
  - Spritz-u. Pressglasserei, Heidenau near Dresden (N 52/F 39)
  - Sachsenwerk in Radeberg near Dresden
  - Siemens & Halske, Chemnitz (N 51/K 66)
  - Siemens & Halske, Zwonitz (N 51/K 53)
  - Kober & Co., Suhl (M 51/J 02)
- SAG Pribor was dissolved in August 1948 and its enterprises subordinated to SAG Totshmach which, in turn, was dissolved on 1 January 1950 and all of its plants transferred to SAG Kabel, SAG Transmach, and SAG Avtovelo.
