1. Several advance parties of the 6th Division, of 50 to 200 troops each, arrived at Camp Werder near Jueterbog on 5 and 6 April 1951. The occupation of the individual camp sections was as follows:

Sections 1 and 2: Occupied since 5 April by a unit from Jueterbog-Altes Lager with vehicles [redacted] 50X1-HUM

Section 3: Occupied since 5 April by a unit from an undetermined post with motor vehicles [redacted] 50X1-HUM

Section 4: Occupied since 6 April by the advance party of an unidentified unit.

Section 11: Occupied by an advance party of Unit Solotov from Wittenberg.

Section 12: Occupied since 6 April by an advance party of Unit Kolvokov or Shernikov from Wittenberg with motor vehicles [redacted] 50X1-HUM

The unit itself was expected to arrive on 14 and 15 April.

Section 13: Occupied since 5 April by an advance party of Unit Krasilnikov with vehicle [redacted] 50X1-HUM

Sections 14 and 15: Occupied since 6 April by an advance party of Unit Shriiglov with SP guns [redacted] and JS-3 tanks [redacted]; and by the headquarters and the army post office with vehicle [redacted] 50X1-HUM

2. A train carrying troops with five T-34 tanks [redacted] and trucks [redacted] left Wittenberg on the Elbe River for Camp Werder on 14 April. *

9. Headquarters buildings

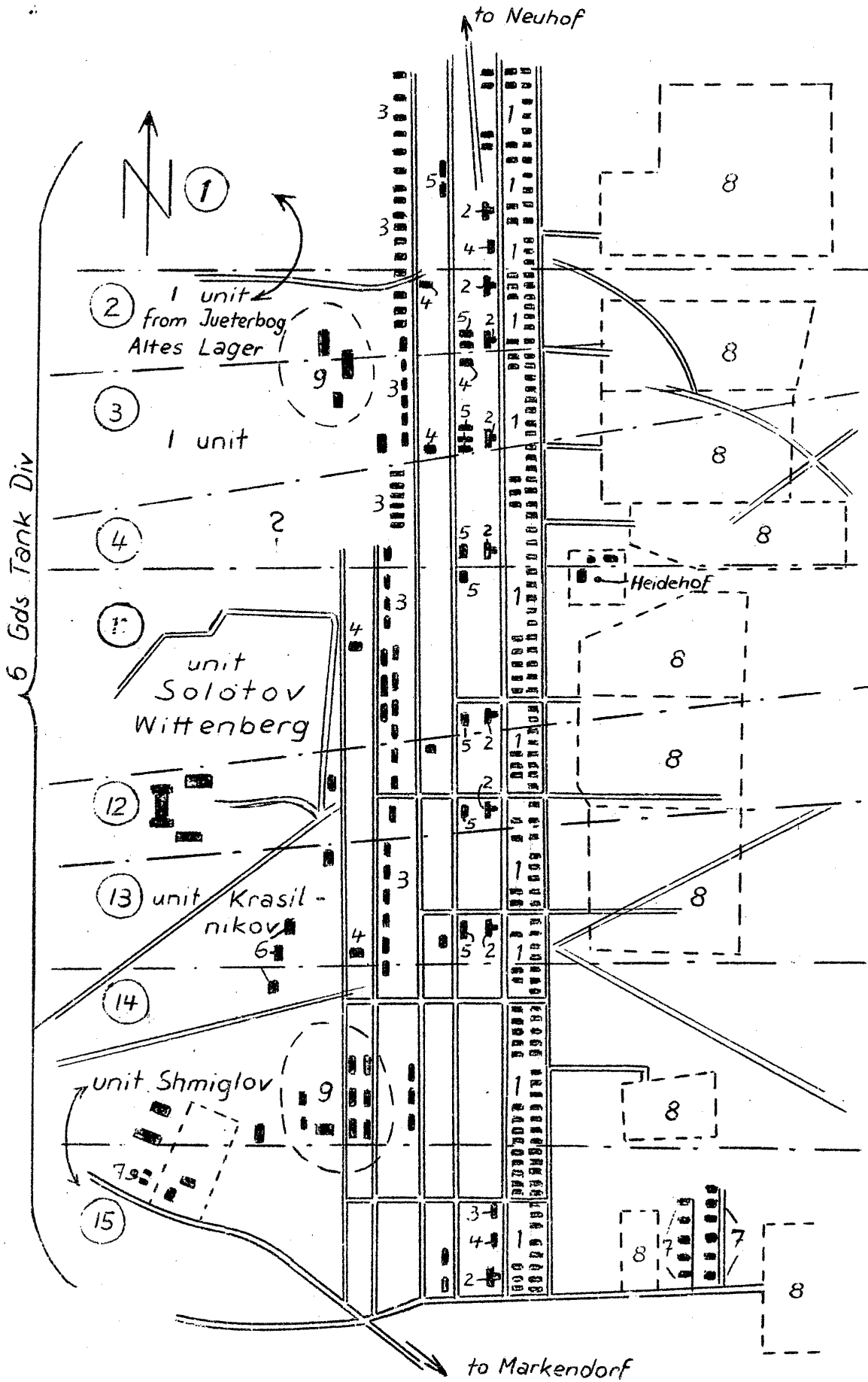
