50X1-HUM

1. Soviet tank troops arrived in Weisswasser aboard six trains on 15 April. Three of these trains came from Cottbus, Vetschau, and Luebben. The dispatching station of the three other trains could not be determined. After being unloaded, the troops moved to the summer camps between Weisswasser and Rietschen. that railroad authorities were **forbidden** to mention any data on the 50X1-HUM operations of troop trains in railroad telegraph or telephone traffic. Only the head of the railroad subdistrict office had been briefed orally on the troop trains by the regional railroad headquarters.
2. Eighteen T-34 tanks and 36 to 38 JS-3 tanks were seen in Camp Nochten in the Weisswasser area on 13 April. The observation towers near kilometer mark 128.6 on the Loxberg-Nochten road were occupied by Soviet military personnel.
