- In early May the Chinese Communist authorities in Canton were attempting to arrest all former supporters and members of WANG Ching-wei's puppet government, including those who served terms under the Nationalist regime after World War II as punishment for supporting the WANG government. All suspicious persons in Canton are deing detained and cross-examined for about eight hours by the Public Security Bureau. If answers are inconsistent the suspect is immediately arrested.
- In mid-lay .AliC Chien-fu (主復夫), a Chinese Communist representative in Hong Kong engaged in gathering intelligence, was gathering information on the activities of the Kwangsi guerrilla representatives in Hong Kong. He was using as unwitting informants his close friends MO Chia-jui (美麗) and CH'EN Kung-chan (東台), Nationalist members of the Kwangai clique.
  WANG operates the I Nan (金角) Transportation Co.; his office is in Room 308 Hsin Huang Hou (新星后) Hotel, Kowloon. He is about 40 years of age, a nation of Kwailin, and icined the Chinase Communist intelligence commissions. native of Kweilin, and joined the Chinese Communist intelligence service in 1949 in Kwangsi, after the province was taken over by the Communists.

  He was recommended to the Communists by LO Yun-feng ( \*\* \*\* \*\* \*\* \*\* ), a senior

  Party member. In June 1950 he was sent to Hong Kong by the Kwangsi authorities.
- In late May training centers for the instruction of fishermen in the gathering of intelligence were being established by the Kwangtung Military District Command in each of the following areas: Yangchiang (111-53, 21-52), Hsuwen (110-07, 20-25), Pethai (109-05, 21-24), in the Wanshan Islands, and at Yulin. Classes are to start on 1 June with 500 trainees in each center. The training period will be for three months.
