- 1. On 15 May 1951 ten guns of about 35 mm. caliber were loaded on a train at the Bötzow station, together with 35 trucks belonging to the 31st AAA Division.
- 2. Two trains loaded with tanks and one loaded with trucks were observed on 17 May at the Wulfen station on the Magdeburg-Köthen RR line.
- 3. Troops with 40 tanks, as well as guns, mortars, engineer equipment, and trucks, were loaded on 10 trains at Dessau between 17 and 20 May. 25X1C
- 25X1C they belonged to the 21st Guards Mechanized Division, a headquarters engineer unit of the Eighth Guards Army, the 57th Guards Motorized Rifle Division, headquarters units of a Guards motorized rifle corps, and an engineer regiment attached to GOFG at Potsdam.
  - 4. Eight boxcars of troops were loaded at Döberitz on 18 May; also eight 37-mm. AA guns, ten 25-mm. AA guns, and 12 trucks belonging to the 1st Mechanized Division.
  - 5. An AAA component of the 1st Mechanized Division with six 76.2-mm. AA guns entrained at the Döberitz station on 20 May.
  - 6. Camp Uchtspringe was vacant and a camp south of Hottendorf was occupied on 23 May. Vehicles of the 18th Mechanized Division and of the 207th Motorized Rifle Division were observed between Jävenitz and Uchtspringe.
