

- 1, On 11 April the following four secret instructions were issued by the Chungshan Military Control Commission:
  - a. Effective 15 April 1951, the Sinc-Macao Frontier Investigation Unit will cease functioning. All members of the unit will turn in their badges and wait for new appointments.
  - b. The Sino-Macao Frontier Preventive Unit will cease functioning. All members will report to the Kungpei (113-32, 22-12) customs office for instructions.
  - c. The Sino-Macao Frontier Anti-Espionage and Self-Defense Unit will be disbanded, and members will report to the Frontier D fense Bureau for reassignment.
  - d. Other temporary village groups which have heretofore filled police and militia functions are to be disbanded. The Farmers' Union will select personnel for police and militia service to replace them.
- The above instructions were all issued by the Canton Military Control Commission the same day they were received from the South China Sub-Bureau.

Comment. The orders were intended to curtail the power of the Military Control Commissions of the various districts, and the compliance of the Military Control Commissions represents a triumph of the so-called International Clique over the National Clique of the Communist Party in Kwangtung.
