Baden

25X1C 1. On 17 April 1951, about 20 officers with maps, who were apparently engaged
25X1C in a map reconnaissance exercise, were seen in the terrain east of the Flak
Kaserne in Baden (O 49/K 37) on the road to Soos (O 49/W 68).

2. Gate guards at Doblhof Castle wore black-bordered black epaulets. Military
personnel, including two majors, who entered and left the castle also
wore black-bordered black epaulets. Six motor vehicles were parked in the
castle yard.

25X1C 3. Soldiers wearing hospital clothing looked out of the windows at 98-100
25X1C Helenenthal. [REDACTED]

25X1C 4. The Helenenthalhof was occupied by troops who wore black-bordered black
epaulets. Some of the troops were cleaning about 20 trucks standing in the
garages.

5. [REDACTED] was parked in front of the radio station at the intersection
of Braungasse and Muehlgasse. Sentries observed there wore red-bordered
black epaulets.

25X1C Soos

6. [REDACTED] was identified at the three-mast radio station in
Soos on 17 April. In addition to the radio hut with four antenna poles
east of Soos, another radio station of the same type was observed a distance
of 10 to 15 meters from the first station.
