1. Between 27 May and 19 June 1951 approximately 7,000 Soviet soldiers left Germany  
to be discharged. They went in the direction of Insterburg aboard five trains,  
[REDACTED]

2. Between 14 and 20 June about 12,000 replacements from the USSR arrived in the  
Russian Zone of Germany via Frankfurt an der Oder aboard eight trains, [REDACTED]  
[REDACTED]

3. A shipment of 30 tanks was observed on 19 June en route from Brest-Litovsk to  
Eisenach.

4. Forty flatcars carrying AA guns and trucks, and 12 boxcars carrying troops,  
passed through Frankfurt on 20 June, coming from the direction of Kuestrin.

Comment: These trips have not been previously reported, and the troop  
movements involved are therefore in addition to those mentioned  
in [REDACTED]
