1. The Tito Guard Division, with headquarters in Belgrade, has been in a state of alert since 24 March 1951. Of recent date it has been supplied with large amounts of modern light armament reported to be of United States manufacture. The Division is also equipped with bazookas.
2. A call to maneuvers has been issued to 60 percent of the reserve officers cadre of the Guard Division, and recently the Division has been engaged in maneuvers for a period of two months.
