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SUBJECT Shipments of Juschneschtrans Transport- und Speditionskontor between 3 and 30 May 1951

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This report, [redacted] lists shipments of the Soviet-controlled Vienna transport firm Juschneschtrans between 3 and 30 May 1951. As indicated in previous reports of this series, because of circumstances [redacted] coverage of Juschneschtrans shipments is not complete but [redacted] has covered 75 to 80 percent of the shipments to the Soviet Union.


✓ 4 carloads of cast iron bathtubs from Hungary to USIA's Construction and Building Materials Industry Administration.

✓ An estimated 15 carloads of coal shipped daily from Poland to USIA.



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
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3. Transit Shipments Handled by Juschweschtrans

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✓ 26 tons of tin bars [redacted] to the Central Commercial Bureau of USIA. (4) 25X1

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✓ 28 carloads of iron pipe, each section 8 to 10 meters long and over one meter in diameter [redacted] to the USSR. [redacted] 25X1

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(1) [redacted] Comment: Although this shipment was despatched as USIA property, it is possible that part of this scrap was collected from SMV installations.

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(2) [redacted] Comment: [redacted] 25X1  
[redacted] Mannesmann-Frauzl A.G. shipped a complete rotary drilling installation valued at \$109,503.40 to Polimex, Warsaw.

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(4) [redacted] Comment: This shipment was forwarded [redacted] 25X1  
[redacted] to Vienna where it was turned over to Juschweschtrans sometime between 16 and 30 May 1951 for delivery to a USIA warehouse in Lower Austria. The ultimate destination of the tin is not known. Prior to the arrival of this shipment the Central Commercial Bureau of USIA is reported to have received delivery of two carloads of tin [redacted] from 25X1  
the same supplier.

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
