- 4. The school trained prospective VP officers to fill positions up to company commanders (Kommissar) in nine-month courses. These courses consisted of 3 months of individual training, 3 months of group training and 3 months of plateon training. The training included two hours a week of political indoctrination and three hours a week of political information; 20 hours a month of tactical indoctrination; training with Zekolov heavy machine guns and Degtyarev light machine guns, theoretical training with T-34 and JS tanks, and training with field guns, mortars, parachute guns and mountain guns; theoretical and practical engineer training, including the construction and removal of obstacles, bridge construction, river crossing by boats, demolitical of bunkers, laying and clearing of mines, demolition work and voluntary group instruction on aircraft.
