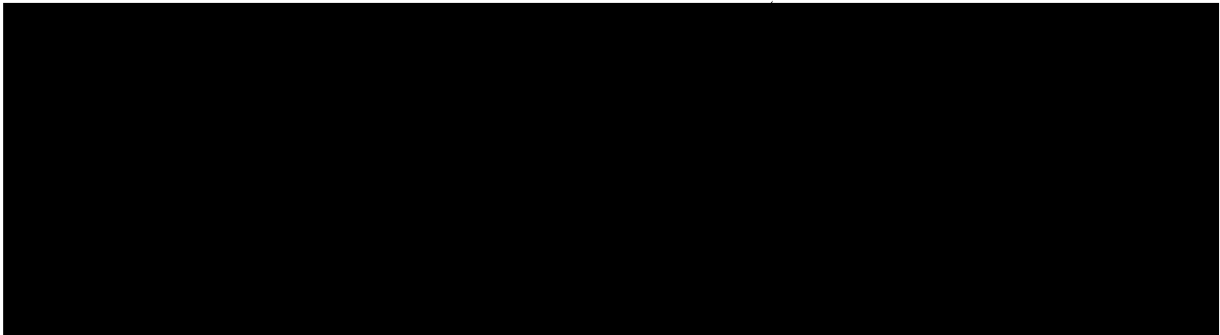

On 12 June a Communist military shipment consisting of 24 truckloads of rifle and machine-gun ammunition and 30 truckloads of infantry gun shells and hand grenades, all products of the Shihching Arsenal in Canton, arrived in Whampoa, and will be shipped to Kwangsi on 15 June by water.

25X1A [REDACTED] Comment. This is presumably the Kwangtung Arsenal at Shihching (113-15, 23-13) which was reported to be producing arms for shipment to Indochina in March 1951. See [REDACTED]
