the clothing depot at Bernau, [redacted] was the central depot for clothing and allocations for the troops in the Soviet Zone of Germany. It was said that all the materials in the depot were manufactured by plants in the Soviet Zone of Germany. Trucks [redacted] were seen entering the depot. (1) (5)

[redacted] 1951, former Heeresbekleidungsamt (clothing depot) II in Bernau was headed by Major Kogan, (fnu), and had a work force of 112 Germans. Building I had a gas chamber in its basement, and contained tools, entrenching tools and gas masks; building II contained the offices of Captain Zalomon, (fnu), and Lieutenant Tomishov, and shoemaker and tailor workshops on the second floor; stocks of fabrics, uniforms and underwear on the third floor; and stocks of footwear and leather equipment in the attic.

Vehicles observed at Clothing Depot II [redacted] 1951 included truck [redacted] and another truck picking up shelter halves at Building II [redacted] three trucks with unknown cargo which went to Liebenwerda on [redacted] and trucks [redacted] and a third truck, which picked up unknown cargo at Building I on [redacted]. Two railroad cars with boxes were unloaded [redacted], and one railroad car with boxes on 1 June. All boxes were brought to Building I. (5)
