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the return of 25,000 railroad cars to the Russian Zone of Germany from the USSR was expected. It was further learned that since 30 April 1951, the German railroad administration has been formulating special plans for handling these cars at the Brest Litovsk North, Central Brest Litovsk, and Gerdauen railroad stations. *

* Comment: This confirms a previous report, which however, mentioned only 20,000 freight cars. This is the first report that Gerdauen, at the Soviet-Polish frontier across former East Prussia, will be used as a point for turning these cars back to German railroad authorities. Standard-gauge axles for these cars have been collected in Berlin-Lichtenberg.

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
