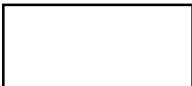

3. During the night of 12 June, several trains, each of 52 converted boxcars with unknown cargo which had come from Kuestrin, were sidetracked along Schubertstrasse, Frankfurt/Oder.

4. Two or three westbound troop trains of 60 cars each were observed on the Gerdauen-Kuestrin-Falkenberg line every night from 13 to 17 June. No heavy weapons were seen on the trains.

Comments:

(1) [redacted] a regiment of the unidentified AAA Div, possibly the 32d, in Frankfurt/Oder until 16 June 1951.

(2) [redacted] shuttle-train [redacted] carrying soldiers, proceeded from Kuestrin via Frankfurt/Oder on 11 June.

(3) These shipments were previously reported [redacted] 25X1

(4) Shuttle-train [redacted] was last reported [redacted] en route from Wuster-25X1 mark to Cuben via Lueterbog between 4 and 6 June. Since the present report states that the train was eastbound on 16 June, it is possible that the train brought soldiers from the U.S.S.R. to the Soviet Zone of Germany between 6 and 16 June.

(5) These shipments were previously reported [redacted] 25X1 Shuttle-train [redacted] was observed [redacted] when it was en route from 25X1 Kuestrin to Rathenow via Frankfurt/Oder loaded with soldiers on 8 June. Therefore the train must have gone to the east once between 8 and 16 June, since it was observed coming from Brest Litovsk on 16 June.

(6) [redacted] belongs to a component of the unidentified AAA division of the Fourth Gds Mezz Army in the Eberswalde-Fuerstenwalde area. [redacted] confirms the 820th Station Supply Depot of the GDFG in Frankfurt/Oder until 14 June. [redacted] confirms the Hq 6th Gds Mezz Div in Bernau until 18 June, [redacted] confirms the 123d Tank Repair Shop of the GDFG in Muellrose until 14 June. [redacted] confirms the Hq 7th Gds Mezz Div in Fuerstenwalde until 18 June.
