1. The explosions which occurred on 1 August 1951, tying up traffic on all main railway lines into Buenos Aires, were probably the work of disgruntled railway workers. Believed mainly responsible are railroad engineers who disapproved the recent incorporation of their union into the CGT.
2. By 2 August 1951 the excitement caused by these events had quieted down. However, periodic outbreaks of a similar nature are expected during the coming months.
3. Neither the Pink House nor the police are unduly excited by these incidents, as trouble of this nature has been anticipated for some time.
