1. LUI Buk Seah (LEI Mu-ch'eng 廖木城), a teacher at Eng Koon Chinese School, 9 Milestone Road, Pasir Panjang, reportedly is a former Communist student leader at Catholic High School, 222 Queen Street, Singapore.
2. On weekends, LUI and an unidentified teacher who is also alleged to be pro-Communist, entertain both male and female visitors at the school. The group spends the evening at the Great World Amusement Park, one of three amusement parks in Singapore which reportedly are used as meeting places for progressive student groups.
3. LIM Lam Choon, who is also known as LIM Gher Hoon (LIN Tzu-yun 林吉雲), leader of a Singapore musical group who allegedly has taught Communist ideology among his friends, was recently detained by Singapore authorities. Upon his release, LIM, who formerly resided at 35 Mohammed Sultan Road, stated that he planned to return to China where he may obtain a government position in Swatow.
