the SS A MLAN had either departed or was about to depart from Beirut on its way to Antwerp with a consignment of 1,130 iron drops containing 470,104 metric tons of copper scrap. The consignment was dispetched by one Amader Lopez Gonez and was insured on 4 July 1951 for 542,420,00 in favor of one José María Larranaga of l'adrid. The company issuing the policy was La Union y ol Fémix Español of Madrid. It was revealed that the ultimate destination of the scrap is Vienna, in care of an unidentified purchaser t erc.

Comment: No indication has been received that the scrap is to be delivered to the eastern bloc, but since a strong possibility exists that a transshipment deal is envisioned, it was considered advisable to place this transaction on record.
