
- . Since April 1951 the Soviet 68 Airborne Division has been in Tientsin, training Chinese Communist troops in that area. This division, which is known as a raider division, was originally one of six raider divisions under the command of the Soviet 68 Army Group in the east coastal area of Siberia. In early August the commanding officer of the 68 Division was Major General Ko-fu-ssu-te (景 伏 斯德) (TGovstyev). In early August the division comprised six paratroop battalions with a total of 120 officers and 2,304 men. There were four commanies in each battalion, four platoons in each company,
- 2. Before late July two Chinese Communist airborne army groups (sic) had already been organized, one in Tientsin and the other in Manchuria. Each group had three airborne divisions. One of the groups was formed from troops selected from the 4 Field Army alone. Both groups were trained by Soviet airborne troops. One of the groups was sent to Morth Korea in early July.
