* Comment. The report refers to open wire telephone lines originating in Berlin from exchange offices in Berlin-Karlshorst, Amt 500, at the former Pionierschule in Karlshorst, and at 32 Chemnitzer Strasse. The previous assumption that these lines continue across the Oder River toward the east has been proved erroneous with regard to the northern line. See [redacted] The northern line branches out at several points, and at Werneuchen consists only of four wires. The purpose of the southern line cannot be determined since its route has been traced only as far as Tasdorf. It is particularly noteworthy that the northern line was heavily guarded at three control points.
