1. Tomas Solano, the owner of the premises housing the Colombian Communist Party's print shop called "Editorial Labor", has demanded payment of the 8,000 pesos which the Party owes him for 20 months' rent.\*
2. Although Solano has not yet taken legal steps, he has stated that he will prevent the Communists from removing the equipment from the premises until the above-mentioned sum has been paid.
3. To date, the Communists have been unsuccessful in their efforts to sell the equipment, which, according to a copy of the inventory of the Editorial Cultura Limitada, consists of articles evaluated by the Communists as follows:
