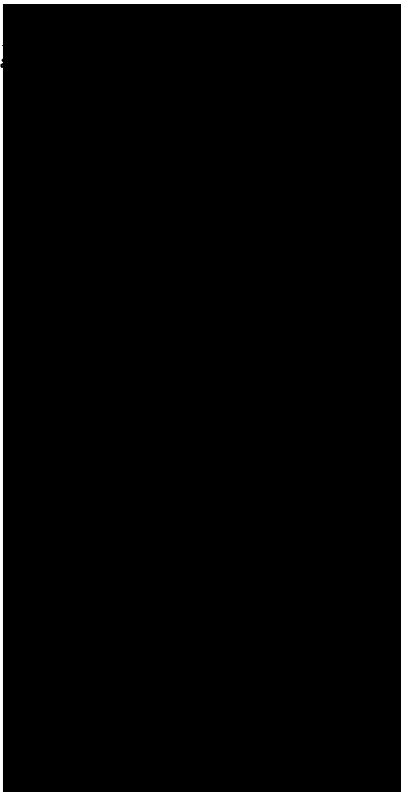

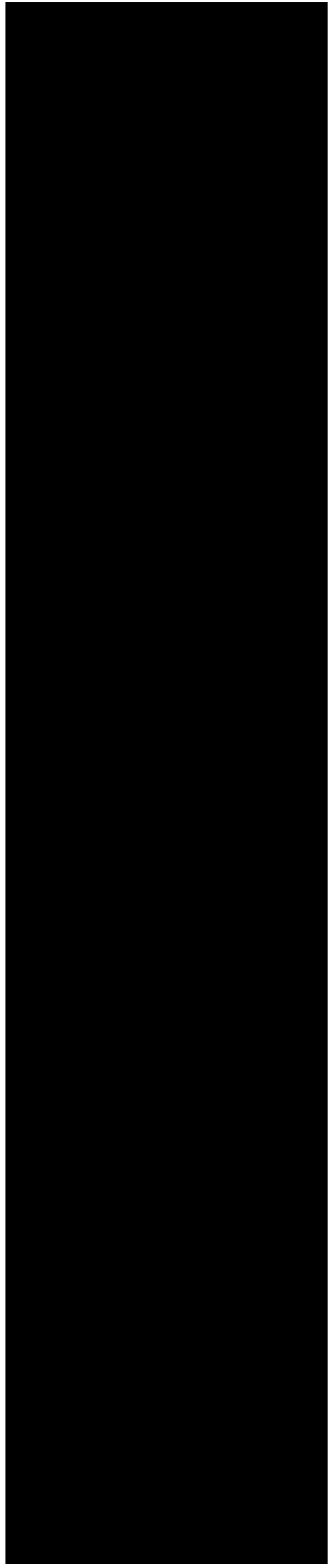

Comments

- (1) The [redacted] is probably the shipment-record number of a troop train rather than an APN. It also seems possible that, coincident to the transfer of the officer and NCO courses from Potsdam and Doeberitz to Wuensdorf, another school of the GOFG was moved to Wuensdorf from the area east of Berlin.
- (2) The two troop trains from Wustermark to Wuensdorf belong to the rail movement effecting the transfer of soldiers of the courses from Doeberitz-Olympisches Dorf, APN 62054, to Wuensdorf on and after 8 July.
- (3) [redacted] Rathenow railroad
- (4) [redacted] belongs to the Hq 1st Mecz Div, which indicates that the train probably carried a component of this division. Other components of the division went to the Altengrabow troop training grounds for short training cycles in May and June 1951.
- (5) [redacted] is assigned to an unidentified regiment of the 31st components of which practiced at Altengrabow in May 1951.
