SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO. 25X1X

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1. The Dacia firm,<sup>1</sup> located at 11 Via Larga, Milan, is negotiating to furnish a large consignment of oil to the Czechoslovak firm Chemapol.
2. Chemapol is attempting to rent 300 Italian tank cars to transport the oil from the Italian ports of Ancona and Venice to Czechoslovakia. Chemapol wants to rent the tank cars for the entire year 1951 and to have an option for all of 1952.
3. No export permit is required, since the oil would be in transit. Actually, the Dacia firm will sell the oil to the Chemapol representative in Austria, Eugen Rubritius, 38 Untere Weissgerberlande, Vienna 3. Officially, Rubritius works for the Viennese firm Butangas, whose Milan branch, located at 11 Via Larga, is handling the transaction.<sup>2</sup>
