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Warsaw-Bornerowo (R 53/P 99) airfield was built about the beginning of 1951; the two runways were completed in late February 1951. In connection with the improvement and enlargement of the field the streetcar line was rerouted. The barracks buildings in the western section of the field were occupied by a Polish Air Force unit and an officer candidate pilot school. \*

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\* [REDACTED] Comment. For sketch of the airfield, see Annex. The air force barracks in the southwestern section of the installation were previously outside of the airfield boundaries proper. According to previous information, the southwest-northeast runway is 2,000 meters long. A technical school for officers, NCOs and EM of the Polish Air Force is located at the field.

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
