1. On 25 June 1951, a van-like truck with a 7-unit antenna was again observed on the hill southeast of Goehren (N 55/P 95). A makeshift double line led from this truck to Goehren. * Four soldiers were seen by the truck.

2. On 14 and 24 June, a radar set was observed southwest of Binz (N 55/P 35). ** A set of the same type was observed on the Island of Hiddensee north of Kloster (N 55/P 47) on 26 June. ***

25X1A * Comment. The same set was previously observed by the same source. It is a RUS-2*type radar set.

25X1A As all the other radar sets on Ruegen Island, the set is probably operated by a signal unit of the Soviet Naval Air Force.

25X1A ** Comment. The radar set, a Dumbo type, is located on Fahrenberg Hill southwest of Binz.

25X1A *** Comment. This set is reported for the first time.
