DO NOT CIRCULATE

On 4 September 1951, 18 Soviet advisors left Nanning for North Vietnam in three passenger cars belonging to the Nanning Highway Administration. Accompanied by a Chinese Communist escort they travelled via T'ientung (107-06, 23-37) and Chinghsi (106-25, 23-09) and arrived at Cao Bang on 10 September. They are now staying at a Democratic Republic of Vietnam guest house in Cao Bang.
