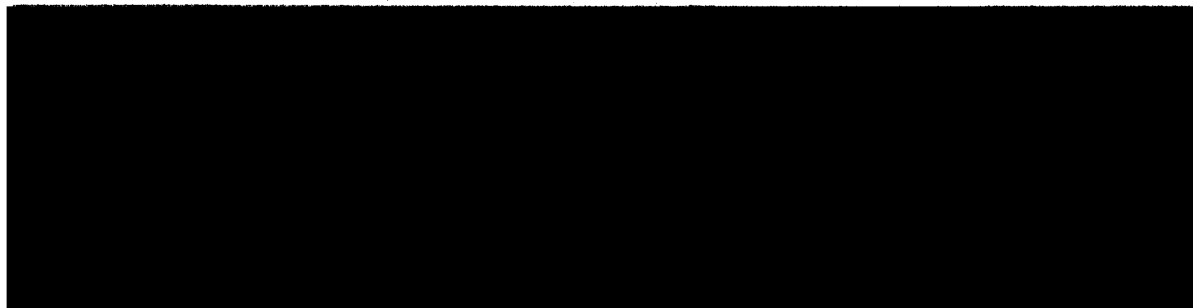

- 1. In early August 1951, the South China Trade Bureau sent JEN CH'ao (任超), a trade specialist, to the Nan Kuang Company in Macao to supervise their purchasing of war materials.
2. The Nan Kuang Company rented the former Luk Yue (陸羽) Restaurant, 118-120 Rua Almirante Sergio, and turned it into a branch office...
3. HO Hsien, LIANG Ch'ang and K'IO Cheng-p'ing rented the SS TA MEI (大美) to operate between Borneo and Macao...
4. On 3 August 1951 HO Hsien, using the name of the T'ung Fu (同福) Company, sold 60 tires (900 x 20) to the Nan Kuang Company.
5. Chinese Communists representatives in Hong Kong purchased more than 200 German-made miniature cameras from the Ta Ch'ang Company...
6. The manager of the Ta Ch'ang Company, which formerly was a purchasing agency for the Chinese Communists, absconded with some of the company's funds and the company was forced to close down.
7. On 3 August the junk JUNG HSING loaded 320 50-gallon drums of gasoline at Wharf 23, Macao, and departed for Kongsnoon. On the same day the junk CHEN CH'ENG took 250 drums of gasoline to Kongsnoon.

8. From 3 to 5 August 1951 the following shipments were made from Macao to Canton:
- 3 August: 1,000 drums of gasoline and 100 tons of wire, on the barge KUANG FU LUNG, 300 tons, license number 1540 V.
- 4 August: 460 drums of gasoline, 30 tons of angle (sic) bars, 250 100-kilogram bundles of rubber, 20 200-pound bags of rubber scrap, on the junk KUEI NAN, which loaded at Wharf 34.
- 5 August: 300 200-pound bundles of zinc plates and 500 200-pound reels of wire, on the SS P'ING AN, which loaded at Wharf 6B on 4 August.
